### Minutes of Ancient City Auto Club Board Meeting of January 24, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. at the home of Dewey Porter. Board members in attendance were: Dewey Porter, President; Jim (and Rita) Arpaia, Vice President; Joe Greeves, Membership Chairman; and Fred Cooper; Treasurer.

Dewey Porter led a discussion about the need to find someone to take on the jobs of Secretary and for Newsletter Publisher. Bob and Jinny Quackenbush have been performing these tasks, but have asked to be relieved from these duties. The board acknowledged the excellent work that Bob and Jinny have done in keeping up with the duties of Secretary and in publishing the newsletter. Fred Cooper offered to temporarily take notes and publish minutes until another club member can take over the Secretary duties. After some discussion, Dewey Porter offered to publish a condensed newsletter to include information items and to contain the paid advertising for the vendors that have already paid for the 2019 advertisements.

Fred Cooper provided the Treasurer's report. The club had a cash balance of \$11,440.35 on 12/31/18, and has a current cash balance of 11,620.35.

A discussion was held about the results of the 2018 Car Show, and the selection of a location of the 2019 Car Show. The board concluded that we should continue to use the Florida School for the Deaf and Blind location, and will continue with the participant voting on cars for awarding trophies. It was mentioned that Doug Hunsworth is working on an easier vote tabulating system. Dewey volunteered to be the Chairman, and Joe Greeves volunteered to be Co-Chairman for the 2019 show. November 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019 was selected as the logical date for the Car Show. This will be discussed and voted upon at the general membership meeting on Thursday, February 7<sup>th</sup> at Creekside Dinery.

Dewey and Joe will coordinate with the Florida School for the Deaf and Blind to arrange for the date of the car show after approval by the general membership.

Dewey led a discussion about a proposed donation to the Florida School for the Deaf and Blind. After some discussion, a motion was approved to provide a donation of \$1,000 to the Florida School for the Deaf and Blind, and to fund the two scholarships to FCTC Educational Foundation in the same amounts as last year, which was \$750 each for the two scholarships. These fund disbursements will be presented for approval at the general membership meeting to be held on February 7, 2019 at Creekside Dinery.

A discussion was held about possible future locations for the ACAC general membership meetings. The February and March meetings will be held at Creekside Dinery.

Dewey led a discussion about the Old Guy's Breakfast prizes. A motion was approved to provide \$100 to Dewey for use as prizes at the Breakfast events.

The next board meeting will be held at the Arpaia residence on February 21st at 7:00 pm.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:30 pm.
